### Alberta Bicycle License 2021

An Alberta bicycle license (ABA license) is required by all members to be on any track in the province. Below is the information needed to help you obtain your license for the upcoming race season.

You will need the following to complete your online application;

- A picture of your rider to download onto the application form. (The photo should be of the rider's heads & shoulders, with no hat or sunglasses & on a light single coloured background much like a passport photo)
- > A copy of the riders birth certificate, drivers license or passport (for new rider's only)
- ➤ A form of payment (Visa or Mastercard)

Complete License Cost \$175 + GST:

Payment will be accepted by any major credit card at the end of your application. Breakdown:

- Alberta Bicycle License:
  - \$95 for each rider 17 & under or
  - \$115 for each rider 18+
- O Red Deer Membership:
  - \$80 for each rider 17 & under or,
  - \$60 for each rider 18+

If there are multiple riders in your family, you will be asked at the end of each application if you would like to add another rider before proceeding to checkout.

Please bring proof of registration such as a copy of your emailed receipt or the digital license to the track along with your Red Deer BMX paperwork which includes member application for & codes of conducts for parents & riders.

This is separate from the online forms completed through Alberta Bicycle.

### **Volunteer & Provincial Requirements**

We require your family to complete the Red Deer BMX registration form accompanied with 1 post dated cheque as a volunteer bond for the amount of \$300 dated September 30, 2021 to complete club registration.

(1 cheque per family) Must be submitted at 1st track visit.

We have 2 options to help you meet this requirement:

Option #1 - Work a minimum of 10 volunteer hours at local races & work bees before the 2021 season is over PLUS volunteer at Provincials July 9-11

Option #2 - Work a minimum of 15 volunteer hours at district races & work bees.

Make sure you put your name down on the volunteer sheet so we can log them. Sign ups will be available online and onsite the evening of races.

Only in the event you do not meet these requirements will we cash your cheque at the end of the season. Cheques will be destroyed once obligations have been met.
